Review these red flags, because banks never ask that!



Emails and texts containing malicious links are some of the most common methods of delivering scams and malware to both individuals and businesses. A best practice is to only click links that come from a trusted sender or domain name. Always be careful of links or attachments being electronically communicated to you. If you need to communicate with the sender, use a known method, such as a listed business phone number. Avoid responding directly to the email or text that appears to be unsafe.
